Please note

Dear parents,

Certain guidelines must be observed when attending kindergarten, day-care facilities, after-school care centers or if care is provided by a childminder.

Requirements are set out in the state-specific rules (so-called facility protection rule and quarantine rule) and in the current general decree of the Bergstrasse district of 01. April 2021.

Children are not allowed to attend kindergarten, day-care center, after-school care or be looked after by a childminder if they show signs of illness. If other people who live with the child have symptoms of illness, the child is also not allowed to attend kindergarten, daycare, after-school care or see the childminder

The child may only go there again from the day on which a negative rapid test of the child or the relative with the symptoms of illness carried out the same day is presented.

Possible symptoms are: Fever, dry cough, loss of taste, loss of smell.

Children are also not allowed to attend kindergarten, daycare, after-school care or be looked after by a childminder if a person with whom the child lives has a positive coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 test result (antigen rapid test or test for self-implementation / lay test). The child is only allowed to return to the facility if the person concerned or the child have a negative PCR test. The PCR test may have been carried out the day before at the earliest.

If someone who lives with the child tested positive with a PCR test, everyone in the household must be immediately quarantined. This also applies if the child was tested positive using a PCR test. Quarantine means you are only allowed to leave the house or apartment for a doctor's visit or for a corona test. You are not allowed to have visitors. This applies for at least 14 days or for the duration that the health department communicates to you.

If a person who lives with the child is in quarantine, the child as a contact person may only return to kindergarten, daycare, after-school care or to the childminder once the quarantine has ended for this person.

If you need medical help, first call your family doctor, the on-call service or emergency services and explain that you are in quarantine.
